### Experience

1. Successful senior academic or professional leadership and management experience within higher education as Secretary, Registrar or Chief Operating Officer (or their equivalents) level.

### Abilities and expertise

2. Interest in and understanding of the academic and financial sustainability issues and challenges facing higher education and the Government's or Devolved Administrations' higher education priorities.
3. An understanding of the current institutional accountability frameworks and an interest in contributing to its development in the interests of funding and regulatory bodies, other stakeholders and institutions.
4. A broad strategic view of higher education, with an understanding of how TRAC Development Group's functions can add value to the management of individual institutions and the sustainability of the higher education sector.
5. Comfortable with the technical policies associated with TRAC.
6. An understanding of the way strategic financial and other information is used within higher education institutions and by funders, regulators and government.
